Dear Parents,

I had earlier today emailed you with the school risk assessment in the hope that we would not have to result in any school closures. Despite our efforts to keep classrooms cool and carry on with normal teaching the extreme heat is now making that difficult. We did provide learners with hand held fans but do not have air conditioned classrooms and many of the classrooms at the front of the school are experiencing very high temperatures. The health and safety of our staff and learners is of paramount importance; it feels irresponsible to not take action to keep everyone safe. Consequently, we have made the decision to keep school closed tomorrow, Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July. Work will be set on Microsoft Teams for all classes. Live lessons will not be provided due to the weather causing disruptions in households and health.

The parents – teacher review day will continue to take place as scheduled on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July and End of year reports will be shared with parents on this day.

Year 7 and year 8 parents should attend school with their daughters between 9.00am and 11.30am  
Year 9 and year 10 parents should attend school with their daughters between 12.30pm and 2.30pm

Sports day is still scheduled for Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> July, however this may be cancelled if the weather is not suitable. Students should still come into school with their PE kits on this day.

On Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July, we will continue to have our end of year Talent show and Rewards assembly. School will finish at 12pm on this day.

If there are any outstanding fees all accounts must be cleared before term ends or students will be taken off roll.

Apologies for any inconvenience caused by the changes made, please be reassured the decision was not made lightly. If you wish to discuss this further, do not hesitate to contact me.
